

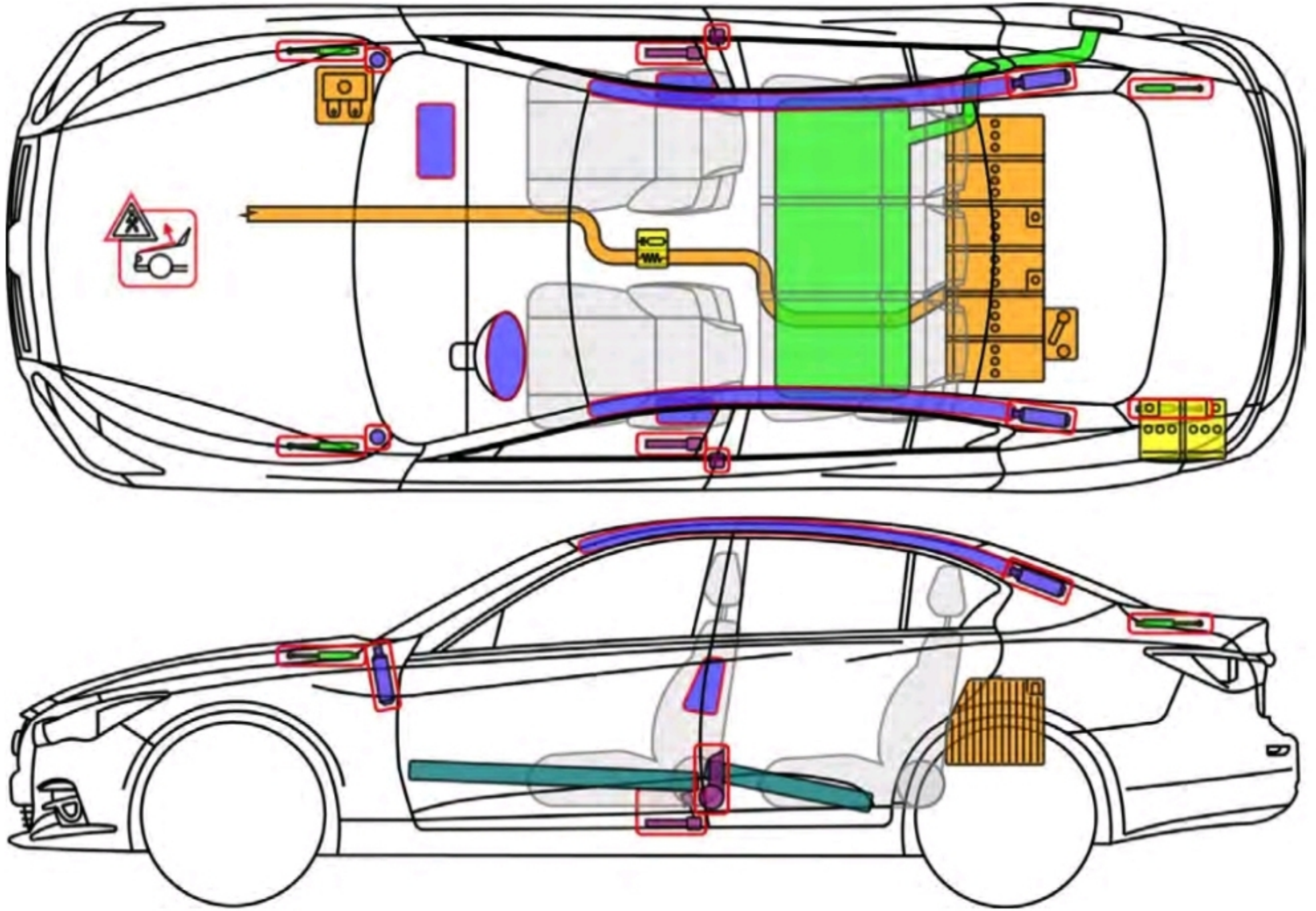

# Infiniti Q50 Hybrid

## General info


- In the event of an accident with an airbag and/or belt tensioner activation, the vehicle drive is automatically deactivated. The supplemental restraint systems remain active.
- The amount of time until the drive is completely deactivated is **10 minutes** after the deactivation steps have been carried out.
- **Protective equipment required (insulating gloves up to 1000 V, face protection).**

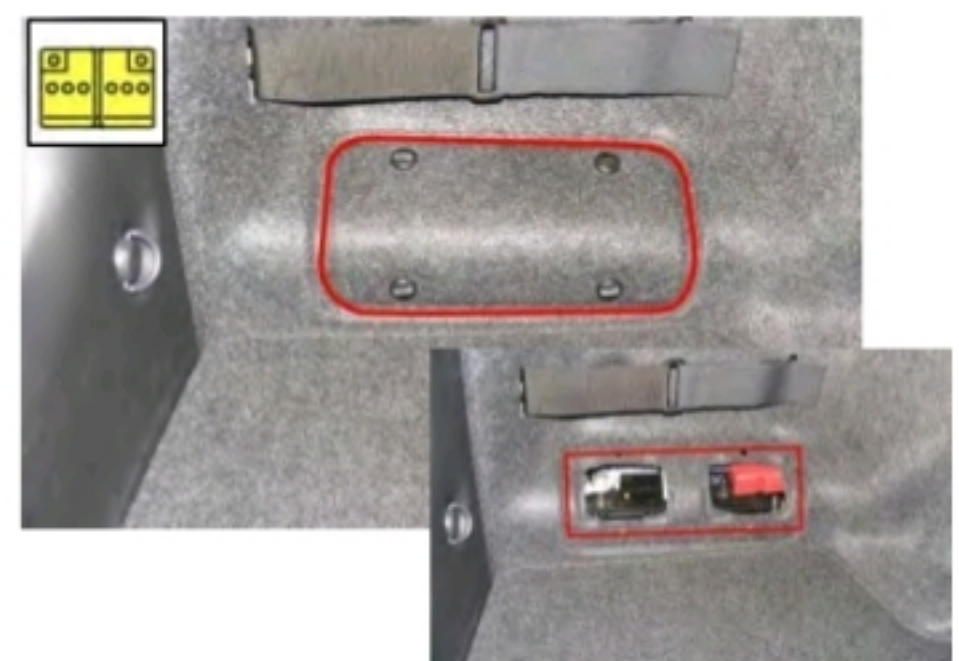
## Secure vehicle against rolling away

- Position wedges under the wheels.
- Activate handbrake.

## Disable high-voltage (HV) and supplemental restraint system (SRS)

### Method 1

1. Check whether the high voltage system is switched on. Symbol: 
2. If the system is active, press the Start/Stop button once.
3. Disconnect the 12 Volt battery. Ground cable first.

### Method 2

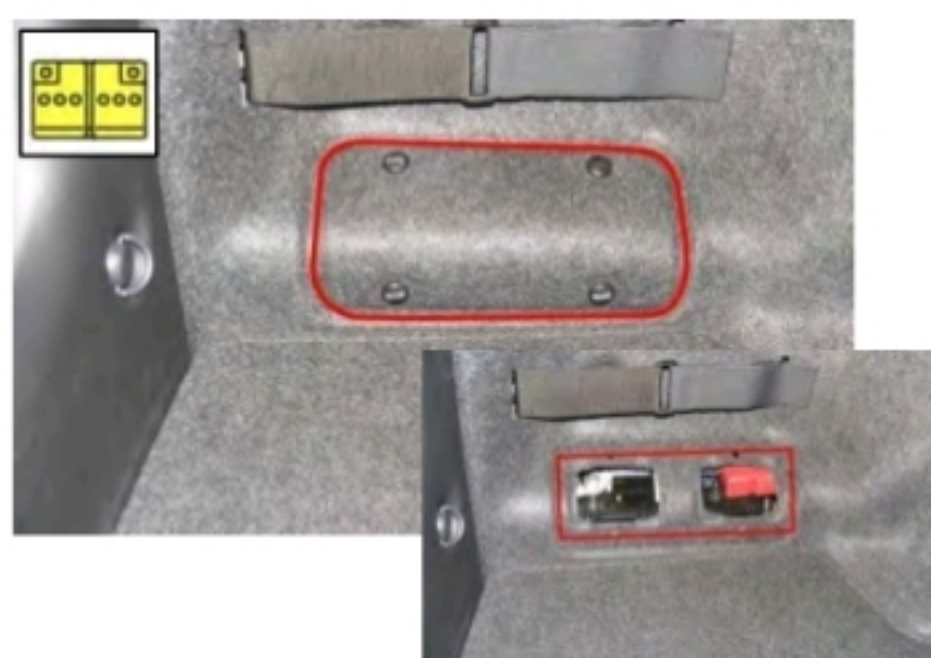
1. Locate and open the fuse box.



2. Remove the fuses shown in the box cover.



3. Disconnect the 12 Volt battery.

### Disable high-voltage (HV) and supplemental restraint system (SRS)

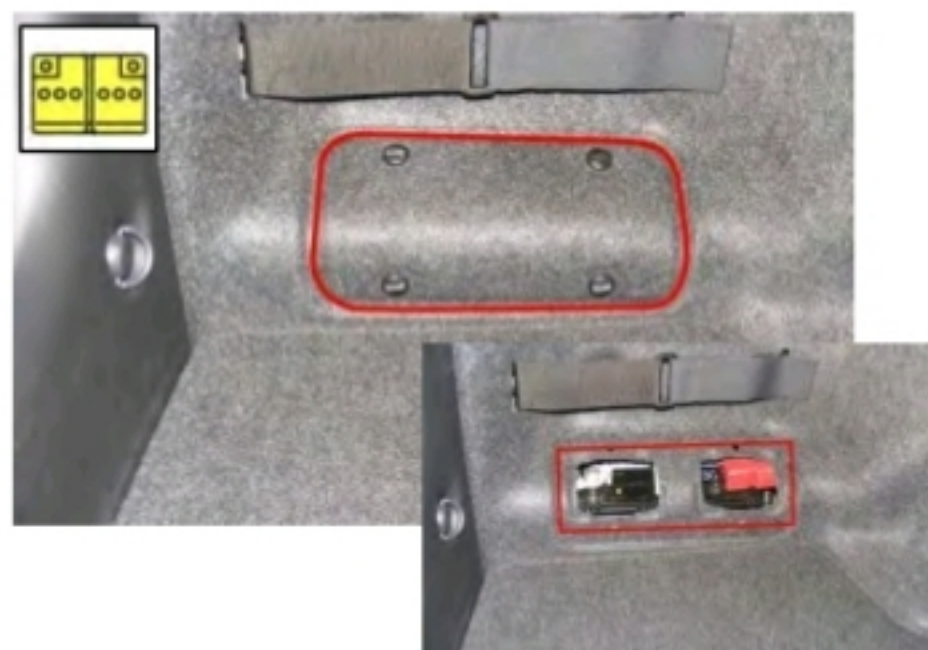
#### Method 3

1. Locate HV disconnection point.

2. Remove service plug



3. Disconnect the 12 Volt battery.  
Ground cable first.



- If the 12 Volt battery can not be disconnected, the supplemental restraint systems continue to be active!
